ArcHydro: GIS for Water Resources

ArcHydro is a geodatabase design and a set of accompanying tools designed to support water resources applications in the ArcGIS environment. The first day presents an overview of the data model and the tools, while the second and third days go into the details of ArcHydro implementation and hands-on operations. Both surface water and groundwater components of the ArcHydro data model will be covered. The participants will learn the basic principles of ArcHydro data model, how to extend it, and how the ArcHydro tools manage and use the data model.

Students will receive the ArcHydro: GIS for Water Resources book (see Book of the Month for more details) as part of your course attendance.

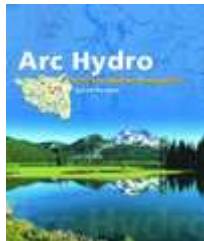
Installing ArcGIS 9.3?

Arc Hydro : GIS for Water Resources
David R. Maidment



Arc Hydro is a data structure that provides the capacity to link hydrologic data to water resources modelling and decision-making methods. This book presents Arc Hydro concepts, components, and

applications. It describes how to:

- Create hydro networks of rivers and streams
- Define drainage areas linked via relationships to a hydro network
- Represent channel shape using three-dimensional models
- Connect geospatial features to time series measurements recorded at gauging sites

The book provides real world examples that can be applied to the Water Resources industry in Australia.
