EastLink Project Wins Victorian Spatial Excellence Award

ESRI Australia client Thiess John Holland received the Infrastructure and Construction award for their use of GIS in the ground-breaking EastLink Project at the recent 2007 Victorian Spatial Excellence Awards.

The EastLink Project is Australia's largest road project to date, and is being constructed by a Thiess John Holland joint venture. As part of the project, an innovative multi-staged GIS strategy was implemented to distribute and manage both location-based and textual data related to the project.

The use of GIS within the project delivered a number of significant benefits to Thiess John Holland, including a 50% improvement in cartographic map production, automated spatial data workflow, faster access for staff to timely and multi-layered data, and improved reporting capabilities.

EastLink and Thiess John Holland plan to continue to develop their GIS capabilities with the further integration of business systems and services.
